



Use of Equipment Policy

Use of Equipment:

The use of library equipment is reserved to patrons 18 years of age and over unless permitted by the library director or under direct supervision of library staff.

Use of equipment is solely the responsibility of the user. The library is not responsible for damage to personal items during use.

The cost of normal equipment maintenance will be the responsibility of the Walworth-Seely Public Library. However, repair or replacement costs due to user negligence will be the fiscal responsibility of the user.

Equipment requiring training or supervision by staff will be designated by the director.

Fees:

Fees may apply for the use of equipment and must be paid in full at time of use. Please see the Library's Fines and Fees Schedule Policy for current costs.

Copyright Law:

Patrons are to be advised that there are restrictions on copyrighted materials which permit, in general, no more than 1 copy of a page for personal use. Violations of a copyright are the responsibility of the patron.

U.S. Copyright Law prohibits the unauthorized reproduction or distribution of copyrighted materials without the explicit permission of the author. Each patron is expected to abide by the Copyright Law.
